

## **Directions for the Stoke Auditorium at Haverford College**

**From the Blue Route rt. 476 North from I-95, or from Blue Route 476 South from the Pennsylvania Turnpike.**

Exit at Lancaster Avenue Rt 30. (Villanova/St Davids) and follow Rt 30 East past Villanova University, Through Bryn Mawr and just past the Haverford School. Turn Right at the sign for Haverford College.

Enter the College at College Lane bearing left at Cope Field, and following around bearing right at Orchard Field, and around past Walton Field. Follow the signs around the campus to the Stokes Auditorium (Building No 16 below). There are no Parking restrictions on Saturday evenings, so Parking is available Near Walton Field or immediately past the auditorium near Building 17. Additional remote parking is available in the visitor parking lot near Orchard Field but requires a long walk across campus.

### **From Philadelphia By Car:**

Join I-76 West (Schuylkill Expressway) and drive west following Valley Forge signs. Take exit marked City Avenue (US 1 South). As soon as you see the City Avenue exit sign, get into the extreme left lane. Once on City Avenue, travel about 2 1/2 miles, turn right on to Lancaster Avenue (US 30 West) and drive about 3 miles through Wynnewood and Ardmore to Haverford. The "Haverford College" sign and College Lane are on the left immediately after the Mellon Bank (also on the left).

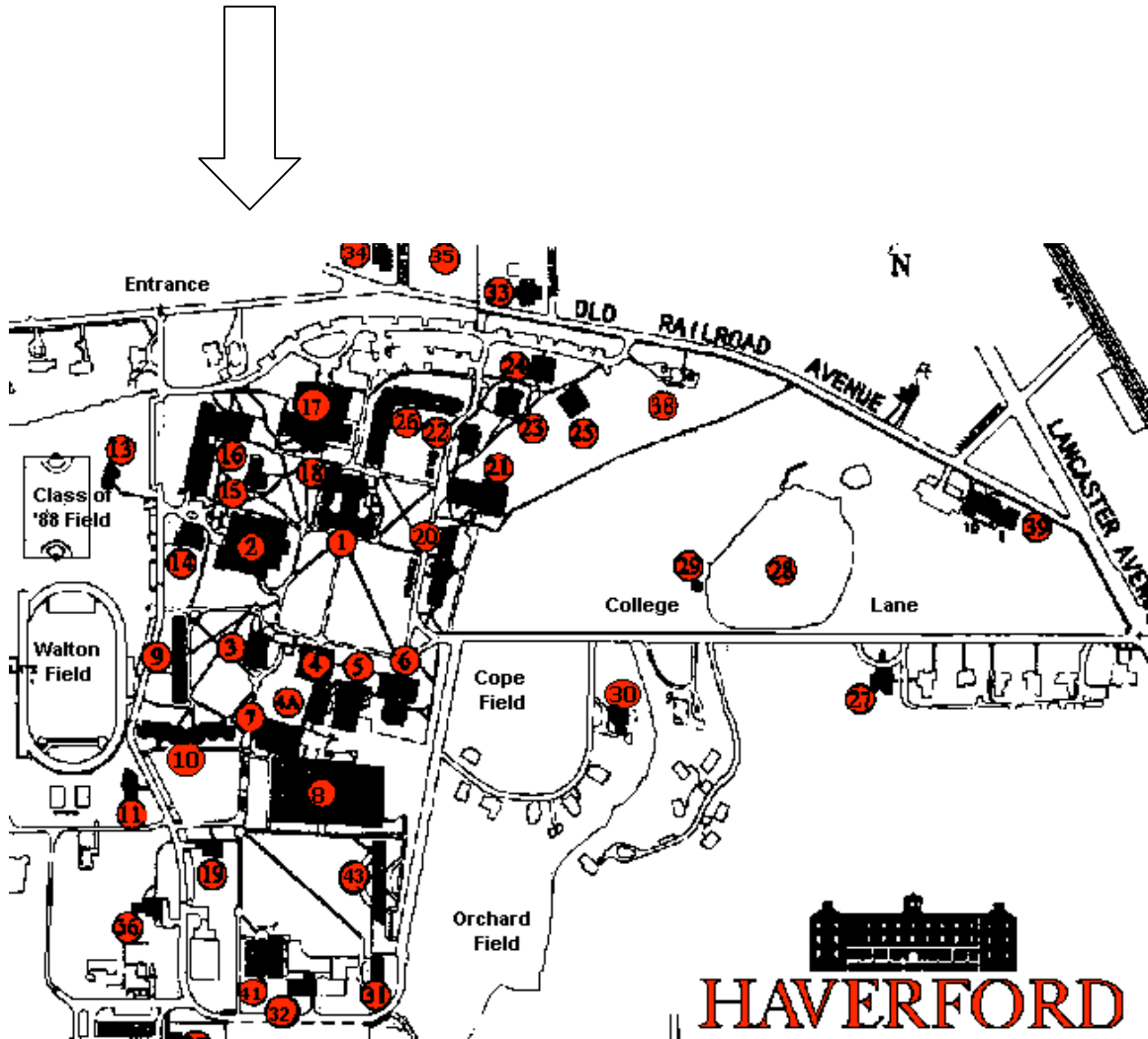
Enter the College at College Lane bearing left at Cope Field, and following around bearing right at Orchard Field, and around past Walton Field. Follow the signs around the campus to the Stokes Auditorium (Building No 16 below). There are no Parking restrictions on Saturday evenings, so Parking is available Near Walton Field or immediately past the auditorium near Building 17. Additional remote parking is available in the visitor parking lot near Orchard Field but requires a long walk across campus. Distance from center city: 11 miles. Estimated driving time: 30 minutes.

### **From Philadelphia by train:**

Go to Penn Center Station (also called Suburban Station) at 16th and J.F. Kennedy Blvd., or to 30th Street Station (Amtrak) at 30th and Market Streets. Take either the R5 Paoli Local or the Bryn Mawr Local to Haverford (not all trains stop at Haverford). Estimated train time to Haverford station: 16 minutes from 30th Street; 19 minutes from Suburban Station.

The walk from Haverford station to the campus is 8 to 10 minutes. Walk down Haverford Station Road, across Lancaster Avenue, right on to Railroad Avenue, left onto campus at Carter Road. Bennett Cab Service operates 19 hours a day (closed 12:00 midnight-5:30 a.m.), seven days a week. Phone (610) 525-1770 or (610) 525-1777.
